## 7 I AM Statements - Book of John

Part 7: I AM the True Vine

#### Homework Assignment

John 15: 1"I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. 2Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away (Lifts Up); and every branch that bears fruit He prunes (cleanes, purify), that it may bear more fruit. 3You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. 4Abide (remain) in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

5"<u>I am the vine</u>, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. 6If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast (thrown) out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw *them* into the fire, and they are burned. 7If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you[b] will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. 8By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

I don't want God to be some emotionless being. You know my fury at anything that would hurt my child, or my grandchild, originates in God. God will find a way to be with you in the middle of your darkness, that's Jesus, in order to destroy that which hurts us.





#### What is Jesus saying about Himself? What is the symbolism meaning?

John 6: 53Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. 54Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. 55For My flesh is [k]food indeed, and My blood is [l]drink indeed. 56He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him. 57As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me. 58This is the bread which came down from heaven—not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever."





Who is Jesus saying this to? Why?

He is speaking to his disciples. They are in the upper room after taking the last supper. These are the final / departing words of Jesus to his disciples on this side of the cross. The next day he will be put on trial, and crucified.

### How did Jesus demonstrate this in His life? Examples

He continually was the source of all good. His healing, his teaching all told of his source which was the love the father

Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Forgiveness of sins, fulfillment of promises, loving us as God loves him

#### Where else in the Bible is this symbolism used?

What comes off the vine? What do grapes make? Wine

He is the true vine, which is the true wine which is the true communion which is also held in the holy place in the temple on the table of showbread.

Galatians 5:4 For if you are trying to make yourselves right with God by keeping the law, you have been cut off from Christ! You have fallen away from God's grace.

Galatians 5 22But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

Matt 15:13 - pulling up that do not produce

Zech 8:12 - seed will grow, God will provide the resources to make it grow

### Where else in the Bible is this symbolism used?

#### Blood sprinkles on Israel - enter in the Old Covenant - EXTERNAL

**Exodus 24:3** Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read in the hearing of the people. And they said, "All that the Lord has said we will do, and be obedient." 8And Moses took the blood, sprinkled *it* on the people, and said, "This is the blood of the covenant which the Lord has made with you according to all these words."



Where else in the Bible is this symbolism used?

#### The Lord's Supper - Drank the blood - enter the New Covenant - INTERNAL

1 Corinthians 11 23For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 25In the same way *He took* the cup also after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me." 26For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.


I am not "the" vine but "in the vine"


