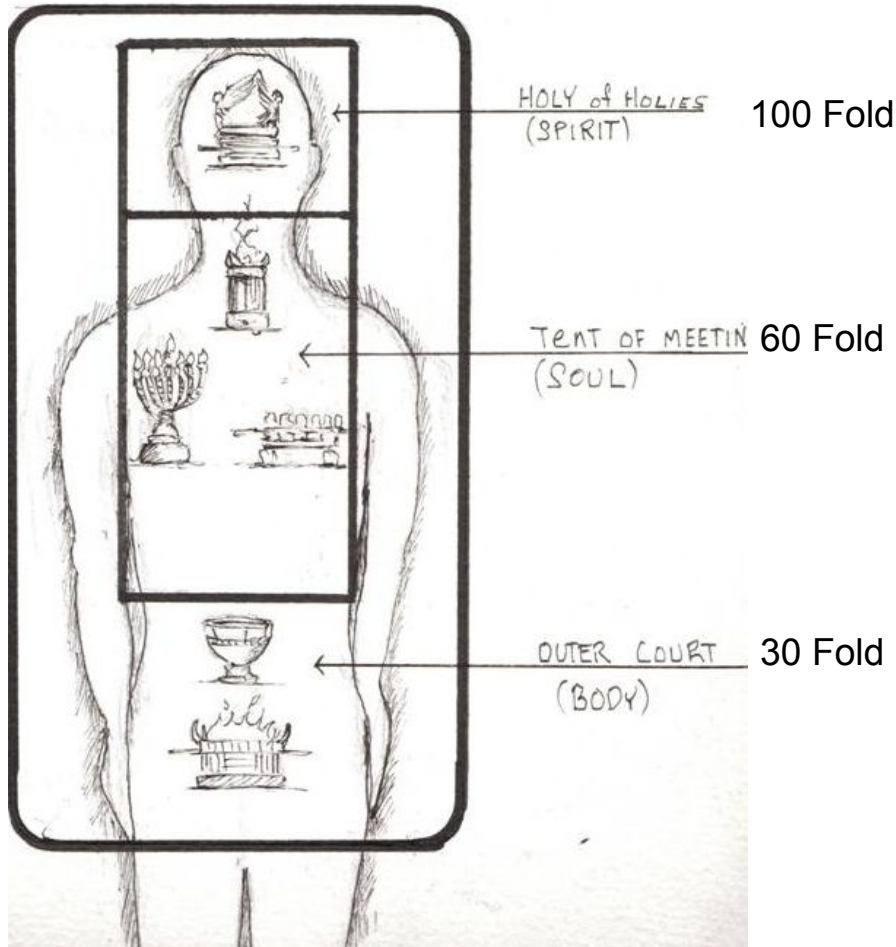

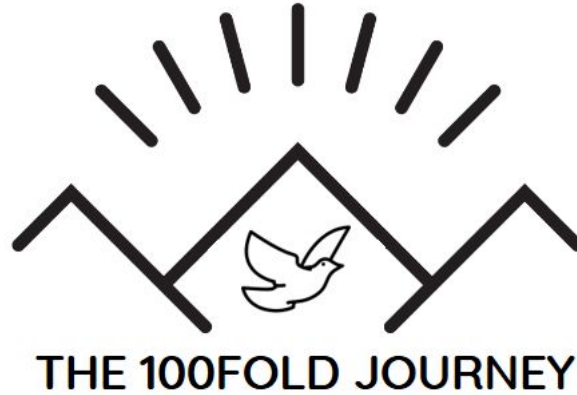

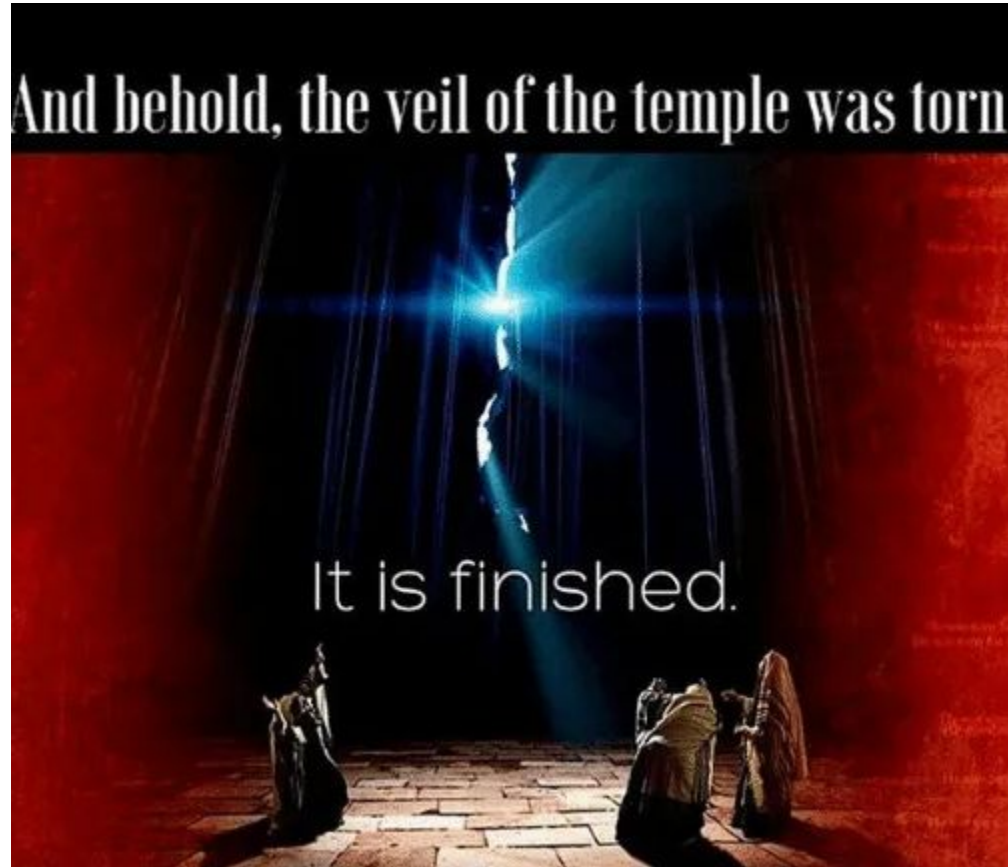

Homework Assignment: Reading

Exodus 25:10-16 **10**“Have the people make an Ark of acacia wood—a sacred chest 45 inches long, 27 inches wide, and 27 inches high.^a **11**Overlay it inside and outside with pure gold, and run a molding of gold all around it. **12**Cast four gold rings and attach them to its four feet, two rings on each side. **13**Make poles from acacia wood, and overlay them with gold. **14**Insert the poles into the rings at the sides of the Ark to carry it. **15**These carrying poles must stay inside the rings; never remove them. **16**When the Ark is finished, place inside it the stone tablets inscribed with the terms of the covenant,^b which I will give to you.

Hebrews 9:3-4 **3**Then there was a curtain, and behind the curtain was the second room^b called the Most Holy Place. **4**In that room were a gold incense altar and a wooden chest called the Ark of the Covenant, which was covered with gold on all sides. Inside the Ark were a gold jar containing manna, Aaron’s staff that sprouted leaves, and the stone tablets of the covenant.

Acacia wood from a practical standpoint, acacia trees would have been one of the only types of trees growing in the wilderness regions traveled by Israel. In addition, acacia wood is dense and extremely strong, making it a great option for any type of wooden construction.

One researcher has noted, "This wood is resistant to decay because the tree deposits in the heartwood many waste substances which are preservatives and render the wood unpalatable to insects making the wood dense and difficult to be penetrated by water and other decay agents."

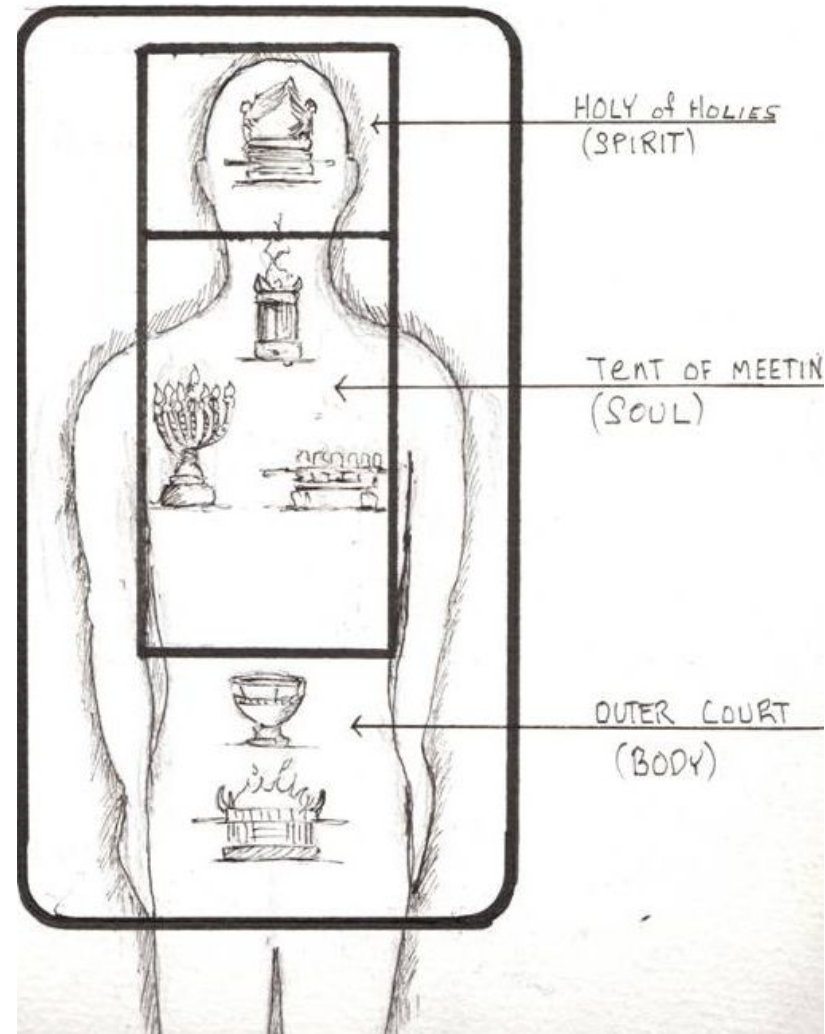

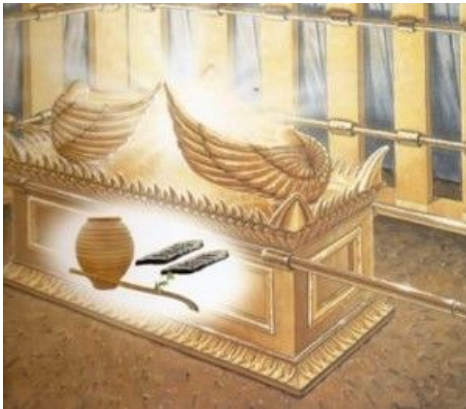

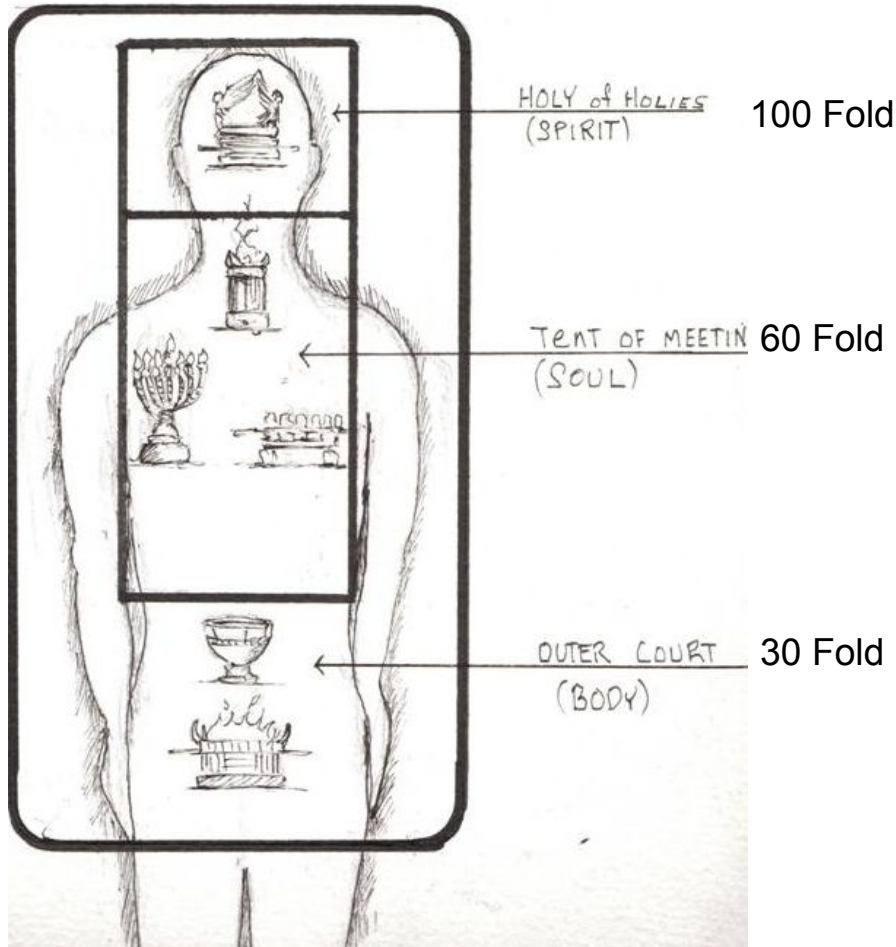
