
Definition: Greek = Metanoia = to change one's mind or purpose Definition: Hebrew = Shub = to turn back, return

Found in Luke 15


Luke 15 <u>1</u>Now all the tax collectors and the sinners were coming near Him to listen to Him. <u>2</u>Both the Pharisees and the scribes *began* to grumble, saying, "This man receives sinners and eats with them."

<u>3</u>So He told them this parable, saying, <u>4</u>"What man among you, if he has a hundred sheep and has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open pasture and go after the one which is lost until he finds it? <u>5</u>"When he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. <u>6</u>"And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and his neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!' 7"I tell you that in the same way, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance (Metanoia)



The Lost Son





So he divided his wealth between them. <u>13</u>"And not many days later, the younger son gathered everything together and went on a journey into a distant country, and there he squandered his estate with loose living. **14**"Now when he had spent everything, a severe famine occurred in that country, and he began to be impoverished. <u>15</u>"So he went and hired himself out to one of the citizens of that country, and he sent him into his fields to feed swine. <u>16</u>"And he would have gladly filled his stomach with the pods that the swine were eating, and no one was giving anything to him. <u>17</u>"But when he came to his senses, he said, 'How many of my father's hired men have more than enough bread, but I am dying here with hunger! 18'I will get up and go to my father, and will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in your sight; <u>19</u>I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me as one of your hired men.""

And they began to celebrate.




Luke 15: 25 Now his older son was in the field, and when he came and approached the house, he heard music and dancing. 26" And he summoned one of the servants and *began* inquiring what these things could be. 27 "And he said to him, 'Your brother has come, and your father has killed the fattened calf because he has received him back safe and sound.' <u>28</u>"But he became angry and was not willing to go in; and his father came out and *began* pleading with him. 29 "But he answered and said to his father, 'Look! For so many years I have been serving you and I have never neglected a command of yours; and yet you have never given me a young goat, so that I might celebrate with my friends; <u>30</u>but when this son of yours came, who has devoured your wealth with prostitutes, you killed the fattened calf for him.' <u>31</u>"And he said to him, 'Son, you have always been with me, and all that is mine is yours. <u>32</u>'But we had to celebrate and rejoice, for this brother of yours was dead and has begun to live, and was lost and has been found."





The Sheep who **Belongs** to the Shepherd he is known by name and is cared for and loved by the Shepherd




The Coin that was lost, but never lost its **Value**



The Son that was lost, but never lost his **Position**




The Older Son who is lost and is unwilling to go into his Father's <u>House</u> into the <u>Party</u>




