


Part 2: Bronze Laver

Exodus 30:17-21 17The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 18"You shall also make a laver of bronze, with its base of bronze, for washing; and you shall put it between the tent of meeting and the altar, and you shall put water in it. 19"Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet from it; 20when they enter the tent of meeting, they shall wash with water, so that they will not die; or when they approach the altar to minister, by offering up in smoke a fire *sacrifice* to the LORD. 21"So they shall wash their hands and their feet, so that they will not die; and it shall be a perpetual statute for them, for Aaron and his descendants throughout their generations."

Exodus 38:8 8 Moreover, he made the laver of bronze with its base of bronze, from the mirrors of the serving women who served at the doorway of the tent of meeting.

Courtyard - The High Priest - 30 fold



Location in the temple? Why is the location important?

2nd piece of furniture located in the outer court

Was placed just outside "the door" which was the entrance to the Holy Place



Location in the temple? Why is the location important?

This was the last thing that you did before you entered into the Holy Place, it was just outside the "door"

We need to know that we are clean and holy, not anything we have done, but what God has done for us, there was never separation only union.

What material was used for its construction? Why? What does this represent?

Bronze = judgement & redemption (bronze serpent Moses lifted)

Notice it is made only of bronze it does not mention anything about wood. So this must have been a single piece of bronze (judgement) beaten / fashioned into this article of furniture

Mirrors from the women of Israel

Mirrors = reflect back what sometimes we cannot see.

James 1:22But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. 23For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; 24for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. 25But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues *in it*, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.

Water = cleansing / purification

Matthew 3:16 As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. 17 And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."

Size & Shape? Why? What do these numbers represent?

No dimensions were given for this piece of furniture.

It had to have a bowl on top of a pedestal in order to hold the water for washing

Interesting, Exodus says: and it shall be a perpetual statute for them, for Aaron and his descendants throughout their generations."

Use & Purpose of this furniture?

Washing the hands and feet

Cleansing BEFORE they went into the Tent of Meeting also called the Holy Place



What spiritual symbol does this piece of furniture represent?

Before you go "inside" remember that #1 you are pure, holy, blameless and #2 which you wash your hands with the word of God and look at your reflection both in the water and the mirrors used in the construction of the Laver you will see yourself as holy and blameless. It is all about seeing yourself as the perfect reflection of God.

The water washes your hands and feet which is a symbol of the "dirt" we can collect as we are in the world. Feet represent us walking around and the hands it touching and collecting which all can cause us to forget that we are spiritual, not physical.

From there, you can go "inside" into the Holy Place and then Holy of Holies

How was this piece of furniture "fulfilled" in the new testament?

This piece of furniture was like a mirror and also provided cleansing:


Titus 3:5He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, 6whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,

Ephesians 5:25Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 26that He might [g]sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, 27that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.

Since you are the temple of God, how is this furniture a symbol of you?

God's word is in me, constantly reminding me of who I am, holy and blameless before him

Ephesians 1:3Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ, 4just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,


