

#### I AM The Dwelling Place of God

Introduction: Tabernacle


#### Homework Assignment: Reading

Hebrews 9:1-14 **1**Now even the first *covenant* had regulations of divine worship and the earthly sanctuary. **2**For there was a tabernacle prepared, the outer one, in which *were* the lampstand and the table and the sacred bread; this is called the holy place. **3**Behind the second veil there was a tabernacle which is called the Holy of Holies, **4**having a golden altar of incense and the ark of the covenant covered on all sides with gold, in which was a golden jar holding the manna, and Aaron's rod which budded, and the tables of the covenant; **5**and above it *were* the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat; but of these things we cannot now speak in detail.


**6**Now when these things have been so prepared, the priests are continually entering the outer tabernacle performing the divine worship, **7**but into the second, only the high priest *enters* once a year, not without *taking* blood, which he offers for himself and for the sins of the people committed in ignorance. **8**The Holy Spirit *is* signifying this, that the way into the holy place has not yet been disclosed while the outer tabernacle is still standing, **9**which *is* a symbol for the present time. Accordingly both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make the worshiper perfect in conscience, **10**since they *relate* only to food and drink and various washings, regulations for the body imposed until a time of reformation.

**11**But when Christ appeared *as* a high priest of the good things to come, *He entered* through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation; **12**and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. **13**For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh, **14**how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?






#### Picture of the Temple = Redemption - East to West

#### God revealed His desire for us through Jesus Until Jesus appeared God set up types and shadows in the Old Testament


Hebrews 8: 3 For every high priest is appointed to offer both gifts and sacrifices. Therefore *it is* necessary that this One also have something to offer. 4 For if He were on earth, He would not be a priest, since there are priests who offer the gifts according to the law; 5 who serve the copy and shadow of the heavenly things, as Moses was divinely instructed when he was about to make the tabernacle. For He said, "See *that* you make all things according to the pattern shown you on the mountain."



What is God telling us?







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

#### Holy of Holies - Ark of the Covenant - 100 Fold







Part 1: Bronze Altar


#### Homework Assignment: Reading

Exodus 27: 1"And you shall make the altar of acacia wood, five cubits (18) inches)(elbow to end of middle finger) long and five cubits wide; the altar shall be square, and its height shall be three cubits. 2"You shall make its horns on its four corners; its horns shall be of one piece with it, and you shall overlay it with bronze. 3"You shall make its pails for removing its ashes, and its shovels and its basins and its forks and its firepans; you shall make all its utensils of bronze. 4"You shall make for it a grating of network of bronze, and on the net you shall make four bronze rings at its four corners. 5"You shall put it beneath, under the ledge of the altar, so that the net will reach halfway up the altar. 6"You shall make poles for the altar, poles of acacia wood, and overlay them with bronze. 7"Its poles shall be inserted into the rings, so that the poles shall be on the two sides of the altar when it is carried. 8"You shall make it hollow with planks; as it was shown to you in the mountain, so they shall make it.

Location in the temple? Why is the location important?

It was located in the outer court

Jesus was crucified outside the camp / outside the
temple

It was placed on a mound so the ashes could be collected underneath

Jesus was crucified on a mound called Golgotha

It was the first furniture as you walked in before you went any further into the temple, which

describes that we need to be aware that God has accepted us and that we are one with him. There is no separation because of what God did to demonstrate that love for us by allowing man, in his full rage and fury kill his only begotten son. Like a lamb slain.



What material was used for its construction? Why? What does this represent?

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Acacia Wood = man
Bronze = judgement & redemption (bronze serpent Moses lifted)
Fire = purification (John 15 - fire burns the works done by man)
Horns = power
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Jesus became man (flesh / wood) and revealed God's love for us (fire) and took on Man's judgement upon himself (bronze) so that He could reveal his power (horn) that no matter what man did or didn't do, his love is unconditional

Size & Shape? Why? What do these numbers represent?

5 Cubits (90 inches / 7.5 feet)

5 is number of grace

5000 feeding (fed with 5 loaves and 2 fish)

5 porches at the pool of Bethesda the healing of the man with infirmity

5 is the 5th letter of Hebrew alphabet = which is the letter hey / open window

50 is the year of Jubilee which is when all slaves in Israel were set free

5x5 = Box measurements of Bronze Altar

Ephesians 2:8-9 **8** For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— **9** not by works, so that no one can boast.

Use & Purpose of this furniture?

Daily sacrifices - for forgiveness

Psalm 51:16-17 For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise

Hebrews 10: 8 First, Christ said, "You did not want animal sacrifices or sin offerings or burnt offerings or other offerings for sin, nor were you pleased with them" (though they are required by the law of Moses). 9 Then he said, "Look, I have come to do your will." He cancels the first covenant in order to put the second into effect. 10 For God's will was for us to be made holy by the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ, once for all time.

The bloodthirsty who would seek revenge on the innocent to relieve the suffering of the many

John 11:49And one of them, Caiaphas, being high priest that year, said to them, "You know nothing at all, 50nor do you consider that it is expedient for us that one man should die for the people, and not that the whole nation should perish." 51Now this he did not say on his own *authority;* but being high priest that year he prophesied that Jesus would die for the nation, 52and not for that nation only, but also that He would gather together in one the children of God who were scattered abroad.


I am pure, holy, blameless.

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
